Hello CCS Community!

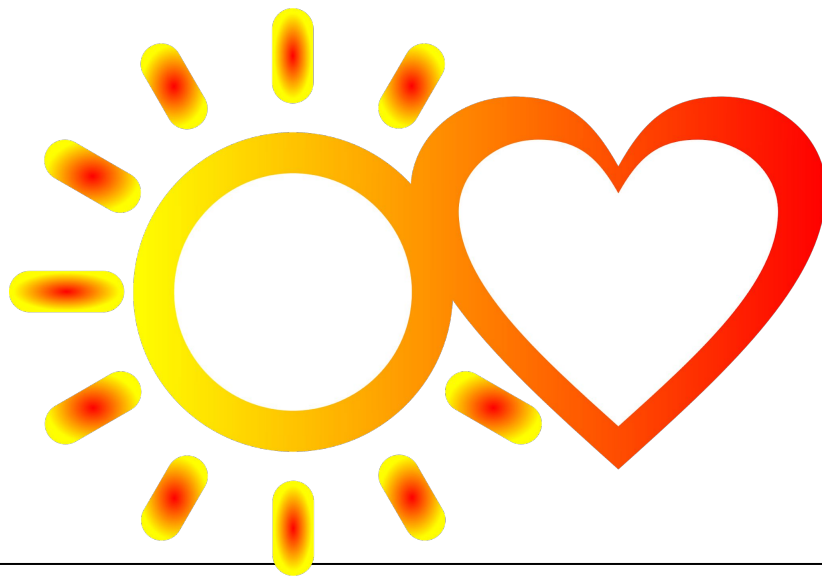

He has a strong love of the outdoors, animals, colors and is always discovering new ideas on how to create!

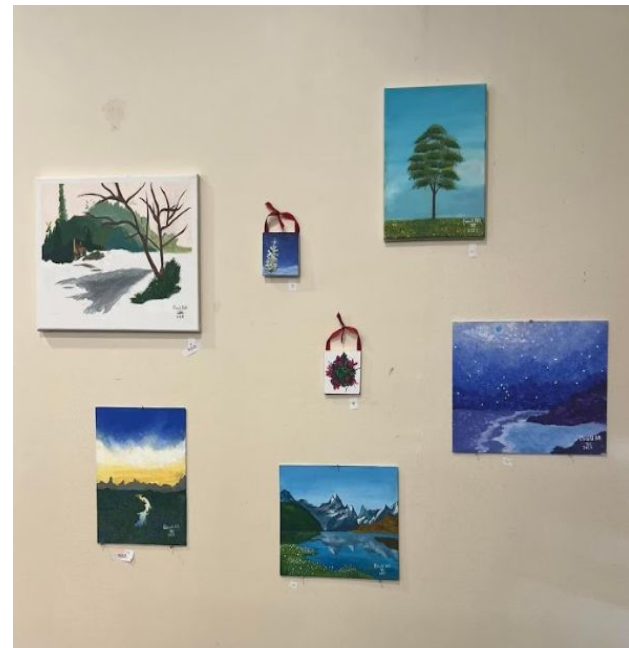
In the past, he has had his talents recognized not only at school
