In May - June 2025, youth in Region 1 schools grades 7- 8 participated in the Youth Voices Count survey. **The survey is voluntary, anonymous, and confidential.** The response rate was 74%. Select results are summarized here; a full report is available on ncpncoalition.org.

Connection to Community



Middle school students are most likely to seek help from their parents (59%) and their friends (49%).



More than 97% of middle school youth reported having at least one **trusted adult** they can share with, and that they feel safe in their **community** and at **school**.

Social Media and Gaming

More than half (54%) report feeling more connected with others through online gaming.



19% report not getting enough sleep as a result of online gaming.

59% report feeling more connected with others as a result of social media.



Almost 1 in 3 have a hard time stopping when on social media.

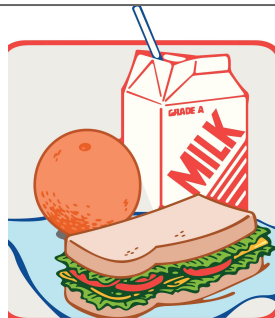

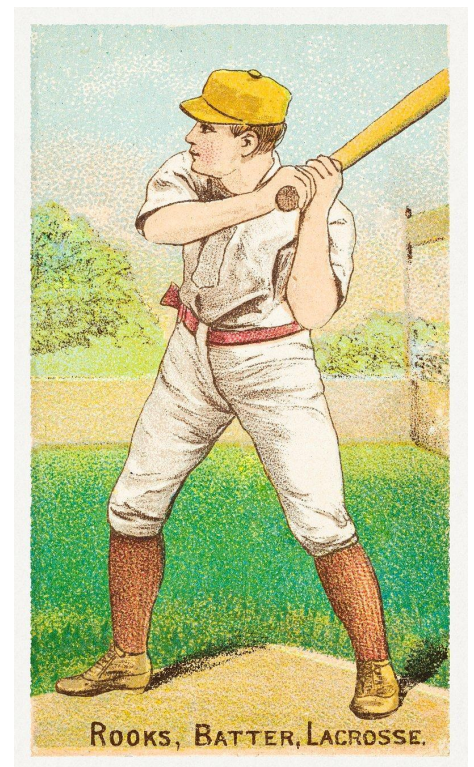

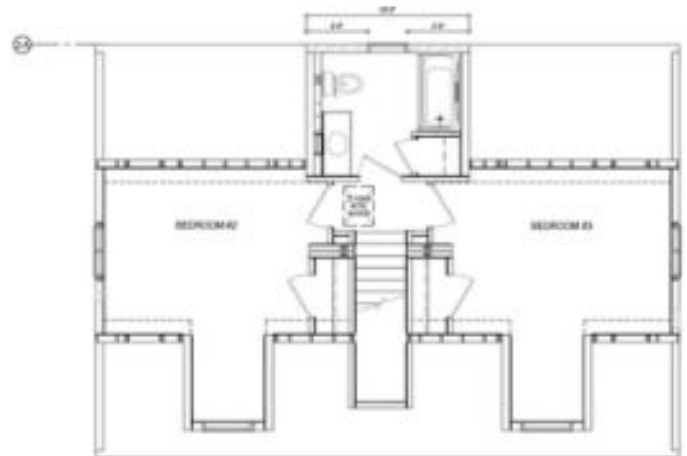

Second Floor

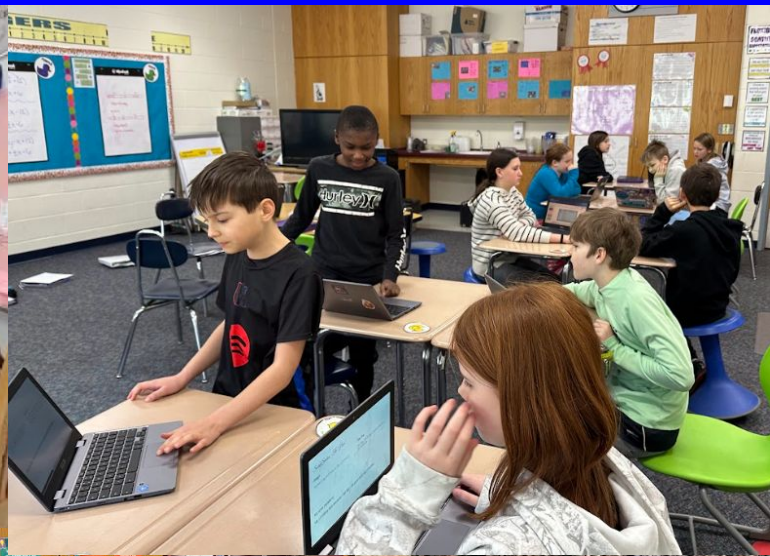

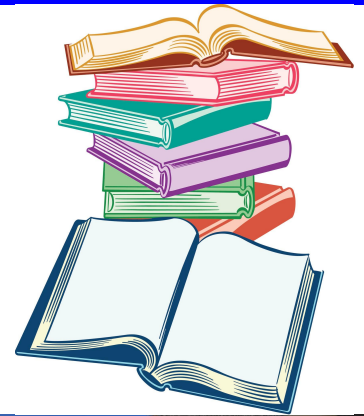
