

#### 2023-2024 CCS Kindergarten Screening & Registration Information

Cornwall Consolidated School Kindergarten Screening & Registration for the 2023-2024 school year will be held at the end of May 2023. All children five years of age and over who reach age five on or before the first day of January 2024 are eligible. Parents should call the school office at 860-672-6617 to get on the list for Kindergarten screening and registration. Parents will need to bring their child's/children's official immunization record, birth certificate, and proof of residency on the day of registration.

#### FOOD FOR THOUGHT!




